

# **125 GAP PROJECT**

Extended I-25 Closures at the County Line Road Interchange as crews continue construction efforts on the County Line Road bridge (exit 163) near Monument, motorists should watch for overnight closures of northbound I-25, southbound I-25 and the County Line Road bridge for bridge demolition next week. 30-minute delays are expected during these closures.

- △ Overnight Tuesday, July 6:
- Northbound I-25 and southbound I-25 closed 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- 🛆 Overnight Wednesday, July 7:
- I⊠ Northbound I-25 closed 6 p.m. Wednesday, July 7, to 7 a.m. Thursday, July 8
- 2⊠ Southbound I-25 closed 7 p.m. Wednesday, July 7, to noon Thursday, July 8
- ⚠ Nightly Thursday, July 8 & Friday, July 9:
- 1⊠ Northbound I-25 closed 6 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- 21 Southbound I-25 closed 7 p.m. to 8 a.m.

⚠ I-25 traffic will use the northbound and southbound I-25 off- and on-ramps to detour around the closure. Access to County Line Road/Palmer Divide Road will be closed at the County Line Road interchange. Use the CO 105 interchange (exit 161) for local access. - branches only, up to 8" in diameter
- ✓ Pine needles (must be removed from bags)
- What is NOT acceptable:
- ✓ NO trash, weeds, or yucca
- ✓ NO construction or building materials ✓ NO nails or wire
- ✓ NO root wads, dirt or rocks
- ✓ NO grass clippings or bags of leaves ✓ NO Junipers
- \*Please remain in your vehicle except to unstrap your load or if you have pine needles only to unload
